McCoy to be Sworn In June 29th

Peoria County Sheriff Mike McCoy will be sworn in as Washington's Chief of Police at 4:30 p.m. on June 29th. The swearing in is open to the public and will be held at Five Points Washington in Banquet Room A.

Mike McCoy has had an extensive career in law enforcement, including Patrolman, Corrections Officer, Chief of Police (Village of Peoria Heights), Deputy Sheriff, and Sheriff of Peoria County since 2002.

We are looking forward to Sheriff McCoy's leadership as our new Chief of Police," explains Mayor Gary Manier. "He comes to us with many years of experience and we are anxious to work with him."
