New Electric Aggregation Program

Several years ago, voters passed a referendum authorizing the City of Washington to seek competitive electricity rates for eligible residential and small commercial retail customers by establishing an “opt-out” electric aggregation program. Homefield Energy was chosen as the retail electric supplier for the current program, which ends on the last meter read date in June. After a thorough bid process, Homefield Energy was again selected as the supplier for a contract term June 2016 to June 2019.

Eligible customers will soon receive a letter explaining this program, the new price, and how to opt-out for those that choose not to participate. No action is required for current program participants who wish to continue in the program.

There have been reports over the years of deceptive marketing practices from unrelated suppliers. Homefield Energy will not initiate any calls or visits. Residents do not have to sign a contract, or pay any fee to participate in or exit the program offered by Homefield Energy.
