BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that traffic from that closed portion of highway shall be	detoured
over routes with an all weather surface that can accept the anticipated traffic, which shall be	maintained
to the satisfaction of the Department and which is conspicuously marked for the benefit of tra	ffic diverted
from the state highway. (The parking of vehicles shall be prohibited on the detour routes to a	illow an
uninterrupted flow of two-way traffic.)* The detour route shall be as follows:

Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways.	
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an occasional break shall be made in the procession so that	
traffic can pass through. In any event, adequate provisions will be made for traffic on intersecting	
highways pursuant to conditions noted above. (NOTE: This paragraph is applicable when the	
RESOLUTION pertains to a <u>parade</u> or when <u>no detour</u> is required.)	
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the hereby agrees to assume al liabilities and	
pay all claims for any damage which shall be occasioned by the closing described above.	
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the shall provide a comprehensive general	
liability insurance policy or an additional insured endorsement in the amount of \$100,000 per person and	
\$500,000 aggregate which has the Illinois Department of Transportation and its officials, employees and	
agents as insureds and which protects them from all claims arising from the requested road closing.	
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this RESOLUTION be forwarded to the Department	
of Transportation to serve as a formal request for the permission sought in this resolution and to operate	
as part of the conditions of said permission.
