It was discussed with the Public Works Committee to again pursue bidding for FY17/18 with the Tazewell County Highway Department's County-wide Bid rather than the State of Illinois' Central Management Services (CMS) state-wide bid. CMS' bid requires a stipulated commitment with a variance of +/- 20%.

The City of Washington committed to 800 tons of salt under that bid (+/- 30%, min 560T to max 1040T). Bids for this contract were opened at the Tazewell County Highway Department on May 22, 2017 with the following results:

As such it is my recommendation that the City Council approve award of their portion of Tazewell County's Section 17-00000-04-GM with Cargill for an amount not to exceed **\$65,124.80**.
