SUBJECT:

Vacuum Truck

Through discussions during the budgeting session for this fiscal year, the replacement of the City's 2008 dual-engine Vactor truck was discussed. It is under a 10-year replacement schedule replacement, advanced by two years to allow for upgrade to tandem unit with additional capacity. This units serves as frontline for not only jetting sewers but also hydro excavating, potholing for critical JULIE locates and other UG infrastructure.

The current budgeted amount of the upgrade is \$400,000, was forecasted with a minimum trade-in of \$77,500 and an accrued MERF replacement budget of \$287,900 leaving a nominal outlay to be split by 75%-12.5% (Sewer-Streets-Water) depending on the option selected.

Vactor and Vac-Con demonstrated their units to the City in mid-May and also a follow up demonstration by Vactor with a two stage fan, all under various real-world situations directed by staff, i.e. a lift-station drawdown and hydro exaction. Staff's concerns with Vactor's move to a single engine chassis power was addressed by Vactor's follow up offer on June 19th to build a dual engine unit. This helped to reduced previous concerns with a single engine - chassis only powered. As such, the dual engine options quoted by both manufacturers are provided below:
