Annual Concrete Supplier Bid (PW-17-03)

On April 17th, 2017, the City awarded the contract for the annual concrete supply to Roanoke Concrete in the amount of \$16,520 for the City's purchase various concrete quantities and flowable fill, original memorandum attached herewith.

While the gross amount of the contract has not yet been exceeded, the original estimated amount of 50 CY flowable has been exceeded due to a number of additional underground repairs. For instance, the most recent work at Bondurant & Jefferson Street required 20CY of flowable in the pavement restoration area. Repairs behind the curb were completed with sand to help minimize expenses.

As such, Staff recommends increasing the amount of flowable fill under this contract an additional 125CY for an increase of \$6,237.50, to an adjusted P.O. upper end of \$22,757.50. This adjustment will still be within the Street Department's budget allowance for such supporting work.

On Wednesday, March 29, 2017, bids were opened and publicly read for the City's purchase and delivery of Class SI ready-mix concrete for various uses by the Public Works Department. The estimated quantities listed below were used for canvassing purposes only and the City is not obligated to purchase these quantities. Bid documents were forwarded to four prospective suppliers and three proposals were received. The following is a summary of bid results.
