Salt Shed Superstructure - Progress Pay #1

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On August 21st, 2017, the City Council awarded the Salt Shed Superstructure Package to Greenfield Contractors using an Accu-Steel High Profile Advantage Truss structure on a foundation (bid and constructed separately by Stark Excavating), for a not to exceed amount of \$58,000.



Progress invoicing attached herewith was received on 11-22-17. This invoice is essentially a material allowance at 75% of the overall project cost or \$42,825 and the project bond at \$900. No lien waivers were submitted; however, the building material is current on-site. A follow up discussion with Greenfield established the lien requirement. As such it is my recommendation that the City Council approve making a progress payment in the total amount of \$43,725.01 to Greenfield Contractors with the submission of an accompanying lien waiver from Accu-Steel.

This matter has been placed on the City Council agenda of Monday, December 4th, 2017 for review and approval.
