SUBJECT:

Salt Shed Superstructure – Progress Pay #2 / Final

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On August 21st, 2017, the City Council awarded the Salt Shed Superstructure Package to Greenfield Contractors using an Accu-Steel High Profile Advantage Truss structure on a foundation (bid and constructed separately by Stark Excavating), for a not to exceed amount of \$58,000.



Progress / final invoicing attached herewith was received on 1-29-18. This invoice is for \$15,775.01, but shows to exceed the original authorized amount due to some additional effort with anchor bolts. While a final lien waiver submitted is pending, it is my recommendation that the City Council approve making a progress payment in the total amount of \$15,775.01 to Greenfield Contractors with the submission of an accompanying lien waiver by Greenfield. This would also require an accompanying motion to approve a corresponding adjustment in the upper end of the contract to \$59,500.02.

This matter has been placed on the City Council agenda of Monday, February 5th, 2018 for review and approval.
