

RE: Purchase of Duty and Training Ammunition

Mayor and Aldermen,

Sergeant Willi sought and received bids from Kiesler's, Streicher's and Ray O'Herron for the Department's annual duty and training ammunition purchase. The bids also include additional training/duty rounds for Sgt. Bean's marksman/observer role with the CIERT/ILEAS teams. Streicher's bid was the lowest. Additionally, they deal with the specific rounds we have chosen for duty use and the specific rounds required for CIERT/ILEAS marksman/observers. O'Herron and Kielser's offer similarly-weighted and constructed .308 rounds, but when dealing with the level of specificity required, that small variance can throw off the rifle's zero. The company's customer service and responsiveness has been exceptional.

The Police Department requests Council authorization for the purchase of training and duty ammunition from Streicher's in the amount of \$11,686.70. This amount is below our budget for this item.
