- 2. Citizens wishing to be heard on a non-agenda item John and Sharon Amdall expressed their thoughts related to the refinancing of the W223 loan. Lili Stevens stated an E-Notify message regarding today's meetings was not sent to the subscription list.
- 3. Business Items
 - A. Review Refinancing Proposals, W223 Property Administrator Culotta provided a brief review of the loan proposals received to date. Chairman Brucks discussed the importance of refinancing the existing loan. Mayor Manier stated the city originally bought the W223 property to prevent the development of a 400-lot subdivision and the impact it would have on our schools. He also mentioned there has been recent interest in the property by a private developer. Chairman Brucks stated the city has adequate reserves and would be able to maintain those reserves even if the city were to pay down a significant part of the principal owed. Following additional discussion, Ald. Cobb made a motion that was seconded by Mayor Manier to recommend approval of a loan with Busey for \$1 million and a 10-year term. The motion passed unanimously.
