SUBJECT: Emergency Repairs – Deer Lane Lift Station

In May of this year the Deer Lane lift station started experiencing float problems causing personnel to be called out for high level alarms. The lift station has historically had problems with grease causing this problem. Because of this it was decided to install a pressure transducer to make the pump station more reliable. The float system is still utilized as the backup.

Personnel from Britton Electronics began installing the new pressure transducer and discovered other problems that needed attention including wiring issues with the pump, corroded connections, and also problems with the Add a Phase. The wiring issues and corroded connections were corrected while crews were on site and discussion about alternatives for replacing the Add a Phase started. Through these discussions it was decided to install VFD's to replace the Add a Phase.

On August 13th Britton Electronics provided pricing and rebate opportunities through Ameren and asked the City to complete the rebate application. On August 23rd the applications were completed and returned for processing by Britton Electronics. Towards the end of the week of September 7th, one of the two pumps at the Deer Lane lift station failed. It appeared that this failure was primarily due to the failure of the "add-a-phase" controller for that pump.

Staff confirmed with Ameren that the emergency replacement of the old "add-a-phase" controllers with VFD's would be permissible provided that the total reimbursable portion of the project cost would not exceed \$10,000. In this case, the eligible reimbursement would be \$125 per HP or \$1,875 per VFD for the 15HP pumps. Temporary repairs were made to the pump station until the two VFD's could be installed.

To date \$15,811.73 has been spent on the repairs and equipment purchases to get the pump station operating. An additional \$19,350 is expected for two new pump purchases for a total of \$35,161.73. Below is a breakdown of the cost associated with these repairs and purchases.

Alternative options to the second new pump purchase would be the rebuild option. The rebuild option from Foremost is 61% of the cost of a new pump and it should be noted that the pump will not have an explosion proof tag. The rebuild option from Fairbanks Morse is 69% of the cost of a new pump, plus freight, and we have been told if they get into the pump and there is anything additional this cost could increase.

Of the total amount above staff expects a rebate check in the amount of \$3,750 to be sent to the City for purchase of the two VFD's. There are sufficient funds within the wastewater budget for these repairs and purchases.

After gathering as many facts as possible staff recommends purchase of two new pumps. One as the replacement for the bad pump at Deer Lane and one to be used as a spare. We are also recommending approval for RNS and the benching fee for Foremost.

This matter has been placed on the City Council meeting agenda of Monday, October 1st, 2018 for review and ratification.
