for a 3 foot front yard variance to construct a front porch

DATE:

June 27, 2019

<u>PZC REQUEST</u>: To allow the petitioners to construct an 8 foot by 26 foot front porch onto the principal structure. The proposed porch would be 22 feet from the front property line. 25 feet is the required front yard setback.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The property is zoned R-1 (Single- and Two-Family Residential) and has a lot width of 71 feet and a lot depth of 120 feet. The petitioners are requesting to construct a wood front porch, replacing a deteriorated concrete slab/porch (see attachments). The proposed porch will be the same depth as the existing concrete and narrower by 18 feet.


## **STAFFS OBSERVATIONS:**

- It appears that the petitioners may not be able to receive reasonable return on their property without replacement of the existing slab/porch.
- There does appear to be unique circumstance as the lot has a shallow front yard.
- It does not appear that there would be any change to the character of the neighborhood as the new porch would not encroach any further into the front yard than the existing slab/porch.

<u>STAFF RECOMMENDATION:</u> Staff recommends approval of the front yard variance request.
