SUBJECT: Water Tower #1 Painting Contract

Award Consideration

Painting of Water Tower #1 is a planned expenditure in the currently Fiscal Year at an amount of \$500,000 with \$250,000 in funding from the Water Tower Reserve fund (cellular lease payments) and the \$250,000 balance from the Water fund. Bid documents supporting this contract were prepared inhouse and issued for bid by legal notice in the Peoria Journal Star published on July 12th and 17th with an opening date of July 31st, 2019 meeting the requirements of 715 ILCS 5/2.1.

Work under this contract includes a base bid of Tank Painting, Complete for both the interior and exterior of the tank using an SP10 sand blasted paint preparation and multiple paint coats (prime, intermediate and finish coats, as well as seam seal and stripe coats) for a total interior painted surface of 23 mils and an exterior of 11.5 mils. Additional work items were bid as optional alternatives, such as Two-Tone Paint to help mask staining of the lower portion of the bowl, etc.

During the bidding process a total of eight potential bidders were plan holders with three firms ultimately submitting bids. One addendum was issued, mainly addressing concerns with tarping operations and proximity to 911 Drive along with how best to approach lead paint on the exterior of the tank should there still be any / enough residual from its original 1960 coating. The base bids of the three bidders are below, with full details attached:

Seven Brothers Painting, Inc. \$548,000 Classic Protective Coatings \$783,365 Maguire Iron \$788,000

While Maguire Iron offered a \$125,000 deduct if the work could be delayed until Spring of 2020, their bid price would still be in excess of Seven Brothers Painting. A follow up conversation with the estimator at Seven Brothers found them amendable to approaching Alternates A2 thru A5 under a time and materials arrangement rather than unit price given the inherent variability of this work.

As such, additional alternate bid work items were included in the bid documents for consideration with the following recommendations:

A review of other budgeted items in the Water Fund finds a \$150,000 for Levee Construction at Water Plant #1. Given that the design contract for this work was just awarded, it is felt that the construction contract could be timed such that it can be a FY20-21 expense and provide the additional funding for this award.

As such it is recommended award the Base Construction Contract to the low bidder, Seven Brothers Painting, Inc. in a not to exceed amount of \$553,900 for the base bid plus the recommended alternate items. It is also recommended to approve an overall budget for this project of \$600,000, allowing for the other identified items to undertaken on an as-needed Time & Material basis.

This matter has been placed on the City Council agenda of Monday, August 5th, 2019 for review and approval.


