This year's budget allows for a planned expenditure for improvements to three lift stations in the amount of \$55,000. These three lift stations will have VFD's installed, a fourth lift station will also see improvement with the installation of a pressure transducer, and all will be connected to the SCADA system at Legion Road.

Staff sought quotes from Britton Electronics and RNS Electric. Both contractors are familiar with the City's facilities and have completed work for the City. RNS declined to quote as the SCADA portion of the project is not his expertise. Britton has done the majority of the work at the lift stations regarding pressure transducers and VFD's and this should reduce any problems with this project. Below is a breakdown of each lift stations cost.
