3. Approval of minutes

Alderman Cobb made a motion and Alderman Yoder seconded to approve the August 19, 2019 regular session minutes. Motion carried.

4. Business Items

A. TIF Subsidy Request - Lindy's Downtown Market - 110 Peoria Street

Planning & Development Director Oliphant reviewed a TIF funding request from Lindy's for 110 Peoria Street to assist in removing and replacing the existing cloth awnings on the front façade of the building. The estimated cost is \$4,898.74 and Staff recommends a 20-percent base subsidy with a 10-percent bonus subsidy for continued investment by Lindy's. The total recommended subsidy is \$1,469.62 to be paid in a single installment.

Following discussion, Cobb made a motion, seconded by Yoder to recommend the City Council approve a NTE subsidy in the amount of \$1,469.62. Motion carried.

- 5. Other Business Treasurer Dingledine reported that very large CDs totaling \$7.6M are being renewed with the result of improving the interest rate. She also reported that she and Controller Baxter are attending the IGFOA conference in Normal and have participated in some very beneficial and informative sessions. Oliphant indicated that Staff is still working on the Boley parking lot across from the Post Office and that the lot has been appraised.
