Agenda Item: Residential Solid Waste Contract Update

Explanation: Staff and representatives of PDC will be providing the City Council with an update of the change from Waste Management to PDC. A transition plan is evolving and a meeting between the City, Waste Management and PDC is taking place on Friday, March 6th to coordinate activities. After this meeting, many of the outstanding questions will be answered. A final plan will be put in place and communicated to the residents.

In addition, as a response to the residents' concerns for those who do not generate a large enough amount of yard waste to utilize the subscription program, PDC has offered an additional service to allow those residents an option. The following will be inserted into the contract and presented to the City Council on March 16th.

F. Access to Landscape Waste Drop-Off Facility.

Residents of the City in good standing may drop off Landscape Waste at Contractor's drop-off facility at 1090 W. Jefferson Street, Morton, Illinois, during the facility's regular business hours, subject to the rules of the facility for a fee of \$2.50 per bag. Non-residents of the City may be denied access to the facility.

They will guarantee this pricing for the term of the contract.

After the meeting on Friday, we will begin weekly meetings with PDC to ensure the transition is moving forward as best as possible and schedule social media and other means of communication so that the residents are prepared for the change.
