Agenda Item: Supplemental MFT Resolution

Explanation: An amount of \$700,000.00 was originally appropriated with an IDOT resolution to complete necessary repairs and improvements on Washington streets and roadways. The bid amount exceeds the original approved amount and the attached IDOT Supplemental Resolution for Improvements outlines the streets/roads that will be improved and needs the City Council's approval to proceed. The project was originally designed and estimated in 2017-2018 and the roads have since deteriorated even more. More patching and edge repairs are need as well as some areas that were originally slated for a chip seal are also now in need of a mill and overlay.

The calculations below were determined by George Merkle with Maurer-Stutz.

Bid Amount:	\$799,246.25
• Original Resolution:	<u>\$700,000.00</u>
• Difference:	\$ 99,246.25
• Change in Plan Request:	\$ 92,269.71
• Extra Work on Steeplechase:	<u>\$ 11,659.68</u>
• Additional Funding Needed:	\$203,175.64

Fiscal Impact: A total of \$855,000 was included in the FY2020-21 adopted budget. A future budget amendment will need to be done if the total expenses for the project exceed this amount. The fund balance in MFT is in excess of \$1.8M going into FY2020-21, including the impact of a reduction of April revenues.
