**Agenda Item:** NPDES & Stormwater Permit Fees

**Explanation**: The City is in receipt of Four (4) invoices from the Illinois Environmental

Protection Agency (IEPA) in the total amount of \$19,000 for NPDES and Storm

Water Permit Fees. The City has been advised to only pay \$2,500 of the \$10,000 STP1 fee because STP1 is in the final stage of decommissioning.

Attached is the email communication with the IEPA and a letter that will be sent

with the payment, explaining the status of STP1.
