**Agenda Item**: Concrete-Bid Award

**Explanation**: On Wednesday, March 24, 2021 bids were opened and publicly read for the City's purchase and delivery of Class SI ready-mix concrete for various uses by the Public Works Department. The estimated quantities listed below were used for canvassing purposes only and the City is not obligated to purchase these quantities. Bid documents were forwarded to four prospective suppliers and two proposals were received. The following is a summary of bid results

**Fiscal Impact**: Approximately \$50,000.00 has been budgeted between the Streets, Water, and Wastewater departments in FY 21/22 for purchase of concrete material.

## Recommendation/

Committee Discussion Summary: Staff recommends award for the City's purchase and

delivery of Class SI ready-mix concrete and flowable fill, for FY 21/22, to United Ready Mix at the above noted unit prices. If approved, this year's prices reflect a 11.4% decrease from last year's bid price if the entire budget is used with United.

Staff also request approval for Roanoke Concrete at the unit prices noted above when United Ready Mix is unable to provide concrete and flowable fill to meet the needs of the Public Works Department to prevent delays in planned work. If approved, this represent no more than a 1.7% increase should the entire budget be used with Roanoke. Roanoke has consistently been the low bidder the last 6 years and provided quality product and service.

**Action Requested**: Approval
