Agenda Item: Granting One Month Extension to Current Liquor Licenses

Explanation: On April 5, 2021, Council was presented with the first reading of an ordinance Approving Liquor License Clarifications and Consolidations with the second reading to take place April 19, 2021. Also, on March 8, 2021, the Illinois Liquor Control Commission extended all liquor licenses with a renewal date of March 31, 2020 or after to June 30, 2021 due to the impact on business from the Covid-19 Pandemic.

Staff is requesting an extension of Washington Liquor Licenses previously due April 30, 2021 to May 30, 2021, allowing the City to utilize the (potential) new reclassified liquor licenses as well as follow the guidance of our State Liquor Commission. These new licenses will expire on April 30, 2022 to capture the full fiscal years revenue.
