**Agenda Item:** Wastewater Treatment-Sludge Disposal

**Explanation:** The Wastewater Treatment Plant produces approximately 900 tons of sludge each year that needs to be disposed of. Because of this, staff has sought quotes from PDC and Waste Management, the only two landfills in the area, with the results of these efforts shown below.

PDC- \$33.00 per ton and will increase to \$35.00 per ton January 2022.

Waste Management- \$45.00 per ton

As you can see PDC is the low quote at \$33.00 per ton. This will increase to \$35.00 in January of 2022.

**Fiscal Impact:** \$35,000.00 budgeted in account# 501-00-590-2500.
