The bids will be opened the morning of the May 10th and the below information will be filled in and emailed to City Council members directly after the bid opening. The bid opening time was set based on IDOT's very particular rules which are not very accommodating. The shorter than normal notification to council was chosen to not lose another week of May. This will give the spray patch an additional week of cure time and traffic to help reduce potential aggregate loss.

This year's project will do some type of improvement on most of the roads south of Bus 24 from Amanda to Lynn.
