- Call to Order Mayor Manier called the special meeting of the City Council on Wednesday, April 28, 2021 to order at 6:04 p.m. in a banquet room at Five Points, Washington.
- Roll Call Present and answering roll call were Aldermen Blundy, Brownfield, Butler, Dingledine, Stevens and Yoder.
- Also present: Finance Director Joanie Baxter, P & D Director Jon Oliphant, Public Works Director Kevin Schone, City Engineer Dennis Carr, City Attorney Derek Schryer, Chief of Police Mike McCoy, City Treasurer Ellen Dingledine, and City Clerk Valeri Brod.
- Pledge of Allegiance All present stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Consent Agenda The Agenda was reviewed and stood as presented.
- Approve Consent Agenda Mayor Manier presented the Consent Agenda for approval of the following items:

 - b) Additional Purchase Authorization – West Street Department Roof
- Alderman Brownfield moved and Alderman Dingledine seconded.
