Chamber Update.

- We currently have 271 Chamber Members, and 243 of those members are based in Washington. There is a difference in the number of paid members, and our 271 members we claim. We have about 80 members that have not paid their dues due to financial hardship related to COVID-19. However, we have not dropped a member during the past year for this. We had a few grants that allowed us to extend this opportunity. However, as we start 2022, these members will again be invoiced. A decision will be made on a case-by-case basis for the members that are still experiencing a hardship.
- We had a short 30 second commercial that aired on six different cable television stations in the month of December. The ad featured a family spending time visiting Washington businesses during the holidays. You can view the commercial on the Chamber's facebook page.
- The Washington Holiday Passports resulted in \$18,910.00 purchased at just 10
 Washington businesses during the Holiday Season. We are looking forward to offering the program again next year, and hope to see more businesses participate.
- We had over \$29,000 spent in Washington Chamber bucks last year. We had more \$40,000 purchased. (A bulk of these were purchased in December 2021, and will likely be redeemed in 2022).
