Whereas, Marcus Jarboe grew up in Washington and is a graduate of Washington District 308 High School; and

Whereas, Marcus Jarboe earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Illinois where he also ran on the track and cross-country teams; and

Whereas, Marcus Jarboe earned his degree in medicine at Harvard Medical School; and

Whereas, Marcus Jarboe completed his surgical residency at the University of Cincinnati before going to the University of Michigan where he completed fellowships in both pediatric surgery and interventional radiology; and

Whereas, Marcus Jarboe is the Director of Pediatric Minimally Invasive Surgery at the C.S. Mott Children's Hospital and has dual faculty appointment with the Department of Radiology as an interventional radiologist; and

Whereas, Marcus Jarboe has performed thousands of surgeries, including a highly publicized surgery to separate conjoined twins at C.S. Mott Children's Hospital with Washington High School Graduate and fellow 2021 Roots Recipient, Christian Vercler.
