Agenda Item: Recodification Proposal - Municode

**Explanation**: The City has been looking into recodifying the City Code for several years as the last full recodification was completed in 2004. Former City Clerk, Pat Brown had researched several companies offering the service and discussed within her municipal clerk circle. As a result, it was determined that Municode is the leading expert in the field with over 4,100 municipal clients, including our neighboring communities of Peoria, Pekin, East Peoria and Eureka.

Municode submitted a proposal for \$18,950 to completely recodify the code over a 10to-12-month period and provide the services as indicated on the attached Executive Summary. Once the recodification is complete, there would be an annual fee of \$3,200 which covers the cost of updating on up to a quarterly basis. There is also a \$450 fee for online hosting with no cost for the first year of service.

- **Fiscal Impact**: The FY22-23 Budget includes \$22,500 for professional services in regard to the recodification. The cost of all three services is \$22,600; however, only the recodification fees will be charged during FY22-23 with the other annual fees assessed after completion.
- Action Requested: Approval of the recodification proposal from Municode in the amount of \$18,950 with added annual fees of \$3,650 after completion of the project.

The recodification base cost of \$18,950 is based on 860 10-point font single column pages (or 972 11-point pages). or 1,075 12-point pages (Current Code is 1,075 pages in 12-point font).

A full-time, Municode attorney will legally review the ordinances, not just a code editor. We will research all legislation against the State Constitution, State Law, and the Charter, and ordinances will be compared to Code content to determine if there are inconsistencies or conflicts within the legislation itself. We will suggest a structure and organization for the code and provide a table of contents indicating the recommended structure. We will also provide State Law references within the code and hyperlinks to internal references within the code. We will provide a legal memorandum containing recommended options and conduct a conference to review the memorandum and recommendations. Our team will edit the text of your code to reflect proper grammar and stylistic consistency; create a subject matter index; create all tables (contents, State Law reference, prior code comparison, and ordinance disposition); and insert graphics into the printed and electronic versions of the code. A draft code will be provided to you for final review prior to printing and shipment.
