Agenda Item: Washington Schools Achievements Sign Location Discussion.

Explanation: As you may know, the City has a School Achievement sign, on North Main Street, on

County Right of Way, outside of City Limits, where Achievement signs are displayed for Washington Schools. Schools will normally reach out to City Staff when there is a new Achievement they would like to display. Typically, as Staff puts new signs up, the older signs are taken down and given to the schools. At this time all of the current signs

are fairly recent, and are not due to be replaced. There used to be a second sign structure, on North Main Street, but was damaged a few years back and not replaced. Staff could build a structure and put it in the same location or Council could give a

recommendation on a new location

Fiscal Impact: Cost of materials to build new sign structure.
