Amending Chapter 136 "Regulation of Licensed Video Gaming"

Background Chapter 136 of the Washington Code of Ordinances references in 136 (F) the number of Video Game Establishments. "There shall be no more than 10 Video Games Establishment in the City in force at any one time." Chapter 136 (G) states "There shall be no more than fifty-four (54) Video Gaming Terminal Permits Stickers in the City in force at any one time"

At this time there is a qualified establishment, in the City of Washington, that requests that they be allowed to operate Three (3) Video Gaming Terminals.

Action Requested City Council Approval for amending Chapter 136 (F) "to allow no more than Eleven (11) Video Gaming Establishments in the City in force at any one time" ...and...amend Chapter 136 (G) "to allow no more than Fifty-seven (57) Video Gaming Stickers in the City in force at any one time."

Also, request that the Washington City Council allow waving of the Second Reading for this Ordinance Amendment.
