Agenda Item: Acceptance of Police Pension Fund Municipal Compliance Report - Revised

#### Explanation:

The Municipal Compliance Report was approved on November 7, 2022 and since that time, the audit has been completed and a required adjustment has been made which impacted the Police Pension Fund and ultimately the required tax levy.

As such, the Municipal Compliance Report has been revised to reflect the updated actuarial calculations.

**Fiscal Impact**: An increase of \$77,889 in the Police Pension Fund property tax levy would be necessary to meet the required employer contribution after factoring in the increase in Personal Property Replacement Tax.
