(Synopsis: Adoption of this ordinance would designate the intersection of Monroe Street and Hamilton Street as a yield intersection).

**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING AN INTERSECTION IN
THE CITY OF WASHINGTON AS A YIELD INTERSECTION AND
DESIGNATING A CERTAIN STREET AS A THROUGH STREET**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/1-1 *et seq.*) at § 11-302 thereof, the City of Washington is authorized with reference to highways under its jurisdiction to designate through highways and to erect stop signs at specified entrances thereto, and to designate any intersection as a stop intersection and erect stop signs at one or more entrances thereto; and

WHEREAS, Monroe Street and Hamilton Street in the City of Washington are highways as defined in the Illinois Vehicle Code, and are within the jurisdiction of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Washington that Monroe Street at its intersection with Hamilton Street be designated as a through street and Hamilton Street at its intersection with Monroe Street be designated as a yield intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, TAZEWELL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Monroe Street at its intersection with Hamilton Street be designated as a through street.

Section 2. That Hamilton Street at its intersection with Monroe Street be designated as a yield intersection.

Section 3. That yield signs shall be erected on Hamilton Street, at or near the intersection with Monroe Street, such that traffic traveling northbound or southbound on Hamilton Street shall be required to yield the right-of-way prior to entering Monroe Street, which said yield signs shall conform to the State of Illinois Manual and Specifications and shall be justified by traffic warrants stated in said Manual.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall not be enforced until the hereinabove referred to traffic control devices shall be erected as indicated.

Section 6. That all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.
