**Agenda Item:** WWTP Security Fence Repairs Purchase Discussion

**Explanation:** The wastewater treatment facility has a chain link fence with barbed wire on the top. Over the years, bricks that were stored on the property started leaning on the fence damaging it to the point it needs to be replaced. There are several fence posts, cross bars and barbed wire sections that need replaced. Staff was holding off on repairs until the bricks and outfall work was completed. Staff had Hohulin Fence come on site and walk the entire Fence. Based on their recommendation the fence is, for the most part, in good condition and just needs mostly minor repairs except for the brick and outfall area. They quoted \$35,000 to complete the repairs stating it would probably be less.

**Fiscal Impact:** Not-to-exceed \$35,000.00 for fence repair and maintenance.

**Staff's Recommendation:** Staff Recommends having Hohulin complete the repairs quoted. This would ensure the security fence is in good condition.
