Agenda Item: Approval of FY2024 Non-Union Pay Plan

Explanation: Attached is the proposed Non-Union Pay Plan for FY2024. The Plan provides for a

2.5% general wage increase (GWI) for all Non-Union employees, excluding

Department Heads and including Sergeants, which is the same increase that is included in the Laborer's union contract. The Police union (PBPA) contract expires April 30, 2023 and thus a new contract is being negotiated and the increase for FY2024 has yet to be determined. Public Works part-time employee hourly rates have been increased in accordance with the Illinois minimum wage which was increased to \$13 per hour

effective January 1, 2023.

Fiscal Impact: This Pay Plan is the basis for the salary increases as included in the FY2024 budget for

Non-Union employees as indicated above.

Recommendation/Committee Discussion Summary: City Council has indicated approval for the 2.5% GWI during budget discussions.
