ENGINEERING – Dennis Carr/Ross Fuller

- The final phase of the Hilldale reconstruction project is quickly coming together. Stark is currently working to finish the final stretches of the new sidewalk. This will be completed by weeks end. Prairie View has been on-site this week working on topsoil placement throughout the disturbed areas in preparation for the installation of sod. Paving has been scheduled for the week of November 13th.
- The Freedom Pkwy extension has been prepared for the installation of curb. UCM has been in contact with Stark to schedule a date to get the stringless curb machine on-site. We anticipate that this will be sometime next week. We hope to see the curb installed by November 10th.
- The groundbreaking ceremony for the Noffsinger realignment project was held this past week. The weather has put a damper on the dirt work that was being done. However, Gensini Excavating plans to begin installing the new sanitary sewer throughout the winter.
- All of the roads that were included in this year's MFT project have been swept by public works after the fog coat was applied. We
 have been in contact with the operator, and he has swept the roads curb to curb to remove any excess rock. We used the GPS to
 measure the fog coat application and will be using these numbers for payment.
- Next week Lonewolf Concrete plans to begin working on the last of the residential curb and sidewalk replacement requests for the year. We had many residents take advantage of the new 70/30 program this year. Lonewolf has been great to work with and have done every job given to them without complaints.
- The Watermain on Stephanie Ct has received the operating permit and some of the new buildings will be occupied in the near future. The developer is still looking at extending Stephanie Ct to the northern segment of Debates this year if weather allows.

FINANCE - Joanie Baxter

- Prepared Management Discussion and Analysis for the audit.
- Following acceptance, distributed the audited financial statements for FYE 4/30/2023 as required to banks and other agencies.
- Year-end reporting:

 - o Annual Treasurer's Report for publication in the newspaper

- Prepared agenda and minutes and held the Police Pension Board meeting on October 30, 2023.
- Participated in a webinar panel for Tyler Technologies in regard to virtual implementations. Tyler created a series of webinars as
 marketing tools and asked me to be on the panel to talk about our experience with implementing the Tyler platform virtually during
 COVID.
- Prepared the application for the Recycling Grant for 2024.
- Prepared the quarterly GATA report for the DCEO Public Safety Equipment Grant.
- Prepared information in regard to the tax levy that will be discussed on November 13th.
- Grant processing steps in regard to the Department of Justice grant for the Evidence Building.
- Jill processed and I reviewed payroll for October 13 and 27, 2023.
- Utility Billing (October 13 November 3, 2023)
 - A total of 5,505 bills were processed and sent in November for October usage, including 548 emailed
 - A total of 528 penalties were assessed for October bills that were delinquent
 - A total of 290 cutoff notices were processed for outstanding balances from September billing
 - A total of 21 accounts were cutoff in October for nonpayment of September bills, 15 door knockers were distributed and 27 payment arrangements made
 - A total of 44 disconnects were processed for November including 22 owing a balance, 16 with credit balances and six with zero balances

- o A total of nine delinquent notices were sent for October disconnects
- New accounts and account closings processed:
 - 37 ins
 - 39 outs
- o Leak detection through RNI and Sensus Analytics software 48 leaks were caught and residents/businesses notified
- There were 21 new residents in October

HUMAN RESOURCES – Maureen Chambers

- Open Enrollment is in full swing. Distributed online form for each employee to fill out and will provide appropriate documentation and info to each employee individually per their needs.
- Currently recruiting for a Public Works Laborer in the Distribution and Collections department. If you know of anyone that would be a
 good fit, please have them send their resume my way. I hope to have a short list of candidates to interview by the middle of next
 week.
- Attended "Lead from Center" enneagram training on Monday. 2nd session to be held the morning of Monday, November 6. Signed up to "vet" the speaker (based out of Metamora) and to see if the topic would be of interest to our staff for our Washington Wellness Program. The self-awareness of our communication and thought patterns helps us better communicate with others. This presentation also focused a bit on how each individual makes decisions, which varies from person to person. Overall, the presentation was more worthwhile than expected.
- Finalized Pre-Trip Vehicle Inspection form that will be placed in PW vehicles.
- Conversations with K. Braskich regarding a few 2024 policy updates.
- Created and distributed November staff newsletter.
- Investigating various anti-harassment trainings. It can be quite uninteresting to listen to the same thing year after year. Anti-harassment training is required each year for Illinois employees. Training will be rolled out on an online platform after Open Enrollment.
- Finalized Employee Appreciation gifting. Hopefully everyone can attend our Holiday Luncheon on December 14. Gift orders have been placed. If an employee did not specify a gift, a \$40 Chamber Bucks gift certificate will be provided.
- Modified Local 231 Authorization and Application documents. Monthly rates are increasing by \$1.00.
- Stuff happens, but if everything goes as planned, I will be taking maternity leave in April/May/June ?? Due date is early April, and I'll be sure to get everyone and everything squared away before I leave.
- Processed handful of termination/retirement/personnel/benefit items.

PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT - Jon Oliphant/Joe Boyer

- The November 1 PZC meeting had two cases: 1) A draft ground-mount solar zoning code text amendment. As has been discussed at prior COW meetings, the intention is to craft a regulatory framework to allow for ground-mount solar on any residential and non-residential properties as a permitted use. The draft amendment has, among other regulations, a minimum lot size of 0.75 acres for non-residential uses and two acres for residential uses. Staff researched many Illinois municipal ordinances attempting to find other provisions that could be used here. The only substantive change to the draft ordinance is the requirement to have a 6' privacy fence installed on the side and rear property lines prior to the installation of a ground-mount array. The PZC unanimously recommended approval of the draft ordinance with the allowance for the owner to instead have an 8' privacy fence surrounding the array provided it would meet the 30' side and rear yard setback requirements. A first reading is scheduled for Monday's Council meeting; and 2) A preliminary plat for Protea Place Subdivision, which is the property at the SW corner of BR 24 and Cummings. It meets all subdivision and zoning code regulations with the exception of a request to allow for a private road that connects BR 24, Cummings, and Lakeshore Drive. Staff supports the request. The PZC unanimously recommended approval of the prelim plat and the private road. A resolution is scheduled for approval at Monday's Council meeting.
- The first reading ordinance for the 120-126 Walnut TIF redevelopment agreement will tentatively be scheduled for the November 20 Council meeting.
- We are continuing communications regarding the possible development of the area around McClugage/Constitution and the properties to the west of Cherry Tree.
- I've been asked to participate on a steering committee for the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission's Active Transportation Plan. This strives to set regional goals for a variety of transportation forms that covers all age, ability, and income levels.
- TCRPC's natural hazards mitigation plan is nearly complete. The draft plan has been finished and will soon be submitted to FEMA for its review. The consultant working on the plan anticipates receiving input from FEMA within the next few months. Following FEMA's approval of the draft plan, each of the participating entities will be required to have a resolution adopted by its respective Boards/Councils. That will then officially allow for eligibility for state and federal funding for projects that are identified in the plan.
- We had our quarterly meeting with PACVB staff to go over their promotion of Washington. Attached is the quarterly review.
- Our staff is close to implementing a new software called SolarAPP+ to handle everything associated with our roof-mount solar permits. Aaron had begun working on this before he left the City and we've begun to pick it up in earnest to handle the sheer volume of permit requests. It will help with the workflow given the continued high solar demand that has been in place for awhile. The link for this will most likely be included with our GIS HubSite that is accessible from the City's homepage.

Staff is working with the City Attorney's office to expedite the demolition of the 501 Walnut building.

PUBLIC SAFETY – Chief McCoy/Deputy Chief Stevens

- For awareness purposes we note the speeding citation issued with the greatest difference between the posted limit and the cited speed during this reporting period: 84 MPH on Washington at Gilman (35 MPH zone); also, of note was 75 MPH on Washington at S Meadowview (40 MPH zone).
- Officer Kelley Noetzol, who we hired away from Bradley 2 years ago, has accepted a position with Pekin PD. We have reserved a January academy slot, the first available.
- IDOT approved closure of the north side of the Square for the Candlelight Stroll.
- Participated in the Nofsinger realignment groundbreaking.
- Officers will train for night shooting next week. WPD trains in low-light shooting techniques at least annually.
- Officers also train next week for physical arrest and control tactics, which in this session will focus on ground fighting (while warding
 off and retaining weapons, because nothing can be easy).

PUBLIC WORKS – Brian Rittenhouse


- Brush collected by Public Works will be burned this month.
- The Street Department is getting plow trucks ready for the winter. We are starting the winter with a full salt shed, which is around 2,000 tons of road salt.
- As a reminder, CIPP lining projects include sewers between BR 24 to East Adams from North High to Harvey, sewers on Madison and Lincoln Street, and a segment on Catherine Street east of Spruce Street. This was originally going to take place in October but has been pushed back to end of November due to scheduling issues.
- The Distribution and Collections Department is working on cleaning the easements for the Georgetown Trunk Sewer and the West Lake Trunk Sewer. This will allow Hoerr to gain access to televise the sewers which will take place in December or January.
- Concentric has been onsite working on the central SCADA system. This will get the three SCADA systems centrally located.
- The wastewater treatment plant generator install project continues. The pad will be poured soon and the generator delivery will follow.
- The repairs to the Public Works Storage/Evidence Building will take place this month. Staff will be bringing recommendations to repair the rest of the building and to replace the roof.
- The Wastewater Department filled a vacant position, internally, created when an employee left for another full-time job. Because of the internal transfer, we now have a vacant position in the Distribution and Collections Department. HR will be posting that position externally. We will have another vacant position at the end of November due to an employee retiring. We will go through the internal posting once that position becomes vacant.
