Agenda Item: Proposed Brecklin's Servicenter Redevelopment Project Financial Assistance Consideration

Explanation:

Staff has received a scope of work from Tom Brecklin, owner of Brecklin's Servicenter at 119 Walnut Street, for desired renovations to his business. Mr. Brecklin would like to reimage the business from BP to Amoco. Three prior TIF redevelopment agreements have been approved for this property in 1996, 2015, and 2019. The 1996 project consisted of the installation of four new service islands and the construction of a canopy over the islands. The TIF agreement reimbursed the interest costs associated with the project over five years. It capped any annual reimbursement at the increase of the payable property tax between the year of the project initiation and each of the five subsequent years. It was further restricted to the increase in local sales tax attributed to and generated by virtue of the property improvements. The 2015 project assisted with the purchase of four fuel dispensers. TIF provided for 20% of the funds for the project in a single payment. The 2019 project consisted of the installation of a new roof. TIF provided for 30% of the funds for the project in a single payment.

The proposed work would be to the exterior of the business as follows:

- Remove and replace the existing sign. New LED digits and a vertical lightbar would be located on the sides of the price panels.
- Install an integrated lightbar bullnose on three sides and a flat white ACM fascia on the rear of the existing canopy with two 60" Amoco T&O and one Amoco channel letter mounted on the canopy along with the installation of canopy decals, flag signs, etc.
- Replace 18 LED canopy downlights on the existing canopy due to outages.
- Install four EMV kits and reimage to meet Amoco specifications.
- Paint the canopy islands, light poles, etc. to meet the Amoco specifications.

Of these items, the only component that is eligible for funding assistance per the approved 2022 TIF guidelines is the painting.

Fiscal Impact: The total estimated cost for the items noted above is \$105,840. The painting is estimated at \$5,000. The project scores 36%, which places it in the bottom tier and a recommendation of a subsidy of 20% for any eligible exterior improvements. The recommended subsidy based on the scoring and eligibility criteria would be a not-to-exceed amount of \$1,000 for the painting. There is not anticipated to be any significant additional property and sales tax generation or new employment. A spreadsheet is attached showing the line items for the painting portion of the project and each of the other components.

Action Requested: Staff requests feedback at the November 13 Committee of the Whole meeting on whether to draft a TIF redevelopment agreement to financially assist with this project.
