Agenda Item: Bid Award – 2024 MFT Contract # 24-0000-00-GM

Explanation: The larger project was broken into 4 smaller projects to increase the competitiveness for each section. The bids were opened the morning of the May 2, 2024.

This year's project will do some type of improvement on the roadways around North Street and the roads north of the bypass that are east of Cummings and south of Santa Fe.

Spray Patch Section –

There were 2 bidders. The low bid for this section of the project was Ace in the Hole for a total price of \$25,130.50. The Engineer's Estimate for this section was \$29,765.00

Seal Coat Section –

There was 1 bidder. The low bid for this section of the project was RA Cullinan for a total price of \$384,164.20. The Engineer's Estimate for this section was \$356,394.00

Fog Coat Section -

There was 1 bidder. The low bid for this section of the project was RA Cullinan for a total price of \$106,010.52. The Engineer's Estimate for this section was \$112,435.40

Hot In-Place Recycling Section –

There was 1 bidder. The low bid for this section of the project was American Asphalt Surface Recycling for a total price of \$324,546.30. The Engineer's Estimate for this section was \$324,546.30

Fiscal Impact: We budgeted to spend \$1,000,000 from MFT funds. The total for all 4 sections of the project comes to \$839,851.52 which is around \$17,700 more than the engineers estimate.

Letting Date Insert the date the letting was held.

Approved Engineer's Estimate No entry necessary; this field is completed based on the items entered under the approved

engineer's estimate.

Attended by (IDOT Representative) Insert the name of the IDOT representative(s) that attended the letting.

Bidder For each bidder enter the following information:

Bidder's Name Insert the name of the bidder whose bid appears below.

Bidder's Address Insert the street address for the bidder listed above.

City, State, Zip Insert the city, state, and zip code of the address listed above.

Proposal Guarantee Insert the proposal guarantee for this bidder. For a material letting, this will usually be a

cashier's or certified check for not less than 5% of the amount of the bid or as shown in LRS #7 - Bidding Requirements and Conditions for Material Proposals. For construction projects,

Local Agency Proposal Bid Bond (BLR 12230) will usually be acceptable.

Terms Insert the terms, if applicable, for this bid.

Item No. Insert the number from Schedule of Prices (BLR 12001) or Material Proposal Schedule of

Prices (BLR 12240).

Item Insert the name of the item corresponding with the item number from Schedule of Prices

(BLR 12222) or Material Proposal of Prices (BLR 12240).

Delivery Insert the delivery method for the item listed to the left, if applicable.

Unit Insert the unit of measure for the item listed to the left.

Quantity Insert the quantity of the item listed to the left.

Unit Price Insert the engineer's estimated unit cost for the item listed to the left.

Total This field is automatically calculated; no entry necessary. This is the unit price multiplied by

the quantity.

Unit Price Enter the bidder's unit price for the item listed to the left, from the submitted bidding

documents.

Total This is a calculated field; no entry necessary. It is the bidders submitted unit price multiplied

by the bidder's unit cost.

As Read Insert the total bid price from the bidder's documents. This will be what the bidder calculated,

not what the LPA calculates.

As Calculated No entry necessary; this will be the sum of the totals listed above for each item. This will be

the calculated bid.
