CITY ADMINISTRATION – Jim Snider

- **Proposed Reconsideration of the Police Evidence Building Bid Report**

Following last Monday's discussion of a course of action with the proposed evidence building, the council requested Assistant City Attorney Braskich research the legality of the city staff to negotiate with the low base bidder after the period of time specified in the bid advertisement that bids would be held good. Research did not reveal any definitive legal precedent on this issue.

City Engineer Carr provided me his recommendation below to move forward with negotiations with the low base bidder of the project (PJ Hoerr):

"The bid stipulation that the contractor be informed that we hold the bids for 45 days is not to hinder the municipality. The hold period is a minimum timeframe that the contractor cannot increase their bid due to material price changes. With price changes every day, a contractor is only locked into their bid price for the hold period. If no hold period is established in their quote/bid or the documents, it is mostly held for 30 days. The contractor could still honor the bid as long as it is not rejected. If the low bid would not honor their bid price, then the contract would need to be rebid instead of asking the second low bidder. Once the hold period has passed, the low bidder no longer is legally bound to their low bid prices.

The 45 days, or however long is stated in the specifications, is a safeguard against a contractor adjusting prices while a bid is being reviewed. It isn't a maximum time that a city can hold them, but a minimum for the contractor. Bids remain open until they are rejected by council, or the low bidder declares their bid prices would change after the minimum hold period has expired.

Peoria has CSO contracts currently that are 90+ days out before being awarded even though it's outside of the hold period because of the involvement with the IEPA. The contractor, ICCI, is notified of their awarding of the bid and asked if their bid prices are still valid, and the project moves forward with awarding. This leaves some of the subcontractors in a bind because their manpower prices change, but that is handled per the subcontractor's contract with the prime contractor, not with the city. I would imagine that there would have already been a lawsuit or bid challenge in Peoria over this with as many contractors in this area hungry for work.

We get quotes (material or services) for different items all the time that have notes on it that they are only good for 30 days. Many of these dates pass between the time we receive the quote and can take it to a COW, then to a council meeting, then get a PO, then get it purchased."

After discussing this matter with the mayor, he agrees that we should look at moving forward with negotiations with the low base bidder, PJ Hoerr. Chief McCoy has placed a request for this consideration as an action item on next Monday's Council Meeting Agenda.

ENGINEERING – Dennis Carr/Ross Fuller

- American Asphalt has completed the Hot-In-Place-Recycling for roads included in this year's MFT project. All roads have been measured for payment. UCM will be in to chip seal in the coming weeks. All residents affected will be notified before this process begins.

- Catherine reconstruction is well underway. We have requested that the road remain passable for residents. While it is very difficult at times, Stark is doing their best to make this happen. New watermain has been installed from Main St. to High. There have been several changes to the project already. Everyone has been working well together to make these changes on the fly.
- All traffic control has been removed on Cummings. Oberlander has been pulling wire for the traffic signals. Stark has placed topsoil on the south side of Freedom in preparation for landscaping to be done. This project is nearing the final stages. We hope to see the road open to traffic by mid-September.
- The Nofsinger realignment project is coming together as well. All concrete work has been completed for the portion of the new road between Cruger and Rt. 24. Ameren has been on the north side of 24 working to relocate an electrical line. Once this is completed work will resume for this portion of the project.
- We have not yet received, but are expecting IDOT to send a joint funding agreement for signal work that will be done during the Business 24 mill and overlay project that is going out to bid later this year. IDOT has confirmed with me that they are seeking an expedited award so that the mill and overlay can be done this calendar year. The ADA work will then follow next year.

FINANCE – Joanie Baxter

- Preparation for FY23-24 Audit:
 - Review and reconciliation of all balance sheet accounts to the workpapers and preparation of final journal entries
 - Continuing to upload workpapers and other required information for the audit
 - Continuing to analyze fixed assets, subscriptions and leases; adding new leases and subscriptions to DebtBook and the depreciation schedule along with new fixed assets
 - Making all required journal entries for GASB 87 and 96 along with fixed asset capitalization, disposals and depreciation
 - Auditors were onsite August 5th and 6th
- Jill processed and I reviewed payroll for August 16, 2024.
- Utility Billing (August 3 – 16, 2024)
 - A total of 5,504 bills were processed for August, including 749 emailed bills (13.6%)
 - A total of 495 penalties were assessed for delinquent July bills
 - A total of 51 disconnects were processed for August, including 21 owing a balance, 29 with credit balances and one with a zero balance
 - A total of 10 delinquent notices were sent for July disconnects
 - New accounts and account closings processed:
 - 20 ins
 - 22 outs
 - Leak detection through RNI and Sensus Analytics software – 42 leaks were caught and residents/businesses notified

HUMAN RESOURCES – Maureen Chambers

- 3rd Annual COW Classic was a success. We had great weather for our 2-person scramble event. Nineteen golfers participated.
- Onboarded new Police hire and offboarded one Sergeant.
- Setting up interviews for Distribution and Collections PW Laborer.
- Editing our 2025 Credible Coverage report.
- Meeting with Department Heads to discuss their “People Systems” priorities and needs.
- Working to distribute August newsletter.
- Health Fair approaching on September 19. Confirming list of vendors for event!
- Meetings with two retirees regarding Medicare eligibility.
- Informed employees of unsubstantiated Consociate transactions for 2023 FSA. For employee’s benefit, extended deadline to July 31.
- Set up Lunch and Learn (still need lunch vendor) for October. A representative from ComPsych will be visiting and providing an overview of services for our new Employee Assistance Program.
- Reviewing Workers Compensation claims. Rethinking work comp education for supervisors and employees.
- Processed handful of termination/retirement/personnel/benefit items.

PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT – Jon Oliphant/Joe Boyer

- The August PZC meeting had one agenda item: 1) A 21’ front yard variance request from Nathan Boynton at 119 Hilldale to construct a porch/deck addition that would be approximately 4’ from the south front property line. It is a corner lot and the side that the proposed addition would face is adjacent to City right-of-way and a road has never been constructed there. The PZC unanimously approved the variance.

- Timbers are currently being lifted by crane at the brewpub site to be installed on the second floor while the HVAC and plumbing crews are continuing to do interior work. Exterior masonry work is tentatively anticipated by the end of the week.
- Staff is working with a property owner on S. Cummings to disconnect (de-annex) a small piece of incorporated property to be attached to another that is currently unincorporated. As with annexations, disconnections require approval of the City Council via ordinance. The area to be disconnected is a 45-wide wooded strip that cannot be developed and staff has no qualms with the request. A first reading ordinance will tentatively be scheduled for the September 16 Council meeting.
- A first reading ordinance for the Washington Historical Society's reimbursement request will tentatively be placed on the Council's agenda for a first reading ordinance on September 3. Please note that WHS has indicated that one of the items on its list of expenses, window removal and wood framing installation, has not been completed yet but will be done soon. As a result, the agreement will be drafted to have two payments. The first would be for all of the items previously completed and the second would occur after the work is done and copies of the paid invoices have been submitted.
- Staff anticipates the issuance of a building permit soon for the start of construction of a multi-unit building at 2140 Washington Road.
- Staff had its quarterly meeting with Ashley Hildebrandt of Discover Peoria to go over items of interest as part of the City's agreement. Attached is the 2024 second quarter report.

PUBLIC SAFETY – Chief McCoy/Deputy Chief Stevens

- WPD arrested a man in relation to an aggravated battery; the victim has since died. Our investigation continues. An autopsy is scheduled for Friday, August 16.
- We had a handful of contacts with one unhoused person around the 2100 and 2200 blocks of Washington Road. A storage business representative reported their belief that the person was attempting to live in a rented unit, which was among our first contacts with this person. In this instance, we located a relative who agreed to come from Chicago to assist the person. We had contact with two other unhoused persons recently, which is an unusual number in a short time, but we do not know whether this is a statistical blip or a trend.
- WPD tactical and negotiation members of CIERT worked a call out in Pekin involving an armed man in a home. The event concluded with the man's arrest.
- We announced openings for two sergeant positions and will provide the Police Supervisor Selection Committee with a list of recommended candidates.
- WPD officers used a Taser to assist in the capture of a man who said he was suicidal and armed with a handgun. The man told officers to shoot him. He was cited for resisting and obstructing a peace officer and disarming a police officer (which includes, as in this case, an attempt to take an officer's firearm, and does not apply to only "successfully" disarming an officer). WFD medics transported the man for mental health treatment.
- WPD assigned traffic details at each school for arrival and dismissal times to maintain traffic safety.

PUBLIC WORKS – Brian Rittenhouse

- Crews completed changing out 13 lead service lines on Walnut Street.
- Staff will continue to investigate galvanized service lines to make sure the service material matches what we have inventoried. If lead lines are discovered, staff will plan for replacement.
- Water tower painting bid opening will be at the end of this month. Once staff has a recommendation, we will bring it to the September 3rd council meeting.
- Staff will start detention basin inspections this month. Any maintenance needed on detention basins will take place after inspections are completed.
- The water main installation on Nofsinger Road will take place later this month. This project will connect two dead ends, completing the main.
- The new Lincoln #2 plow truck was delivered Friday. This is the last of the three plow trucks Council approved in September of 2022.

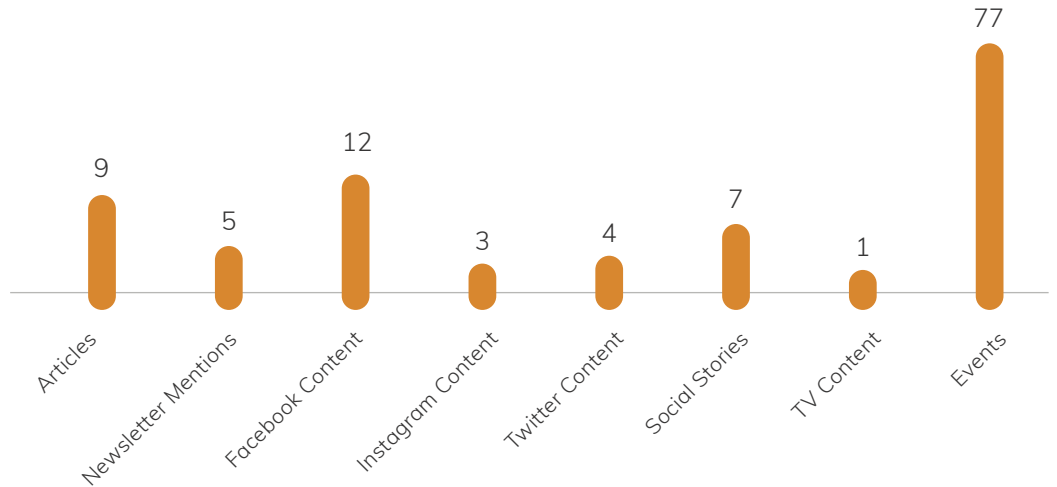
