



CITY OF WASHINGTON Council Report

August 15, 2025

MAYOR – Liliya Stevens

- Attended the swearing in of a new part-time WPD officer.
- Participated in the Washington St. Jude runners send off at Five Points.
- Attended Branches (an organization that hosts monthly care closets on-site at D50 John Hensey school/D51 Central primary and intermediate/D52 Lincoln and WMS) open house located at the former Sunnyland Christian Church parsonage.
- Attended a Discover Peoria event honoring Tres Rojas Winery for their induction into the class of 2025 Illinois Made Makers program.
- Participated in the WPD National Night Out held at Oak Ridge Park for the purpose of building strong relationships between the community and first responders.
- Participated in a Government Affairs meeting where the Morton mayor and I were the guest speakers.
- Participated in meetings requested by residents.
- Participated in meetings related to our upcoming City building space study.
- Participated in staff meetings.
- Participated in a Press Conference called by County Clerk and Bicentennial Committee member John Ackerman about the upcoming Bicentennial Week - August 14th through August 23rd.
- Invited and attended the WFD event where the State Fire Marshal recognized our Washington Fire Department for being the 1st Volunteer Fire Department in the state to hit the milestone of installing 1,000 smoke alarms through the Be Alarmed! Program.

CITY ADMINISTRATOR – Dennis Carr

- We have received three quotes for the remaining windows and will be moving forward with Doerr Siding and Windows for the remainder of the window replacements at City Hall.
- The selection team for the Citywide Space Needs Study held three interviews with the top three rated firms. The interviews went really well and contract fee and scope negotiations will begin with Dewberry for this project.
- Department Heads met with Elizabeth Hanson as part of the Strategic Goal Setting Session. We are currently finalizing the format for a survey that will be sent out early next week for public input. The Public will have until September 8th to participate in the survey.
- Met with a couple members of the Tournament of Champions (TOC) board to discuss the City's involvement. The TOC will present at a future Council meeting for everyone to participate in.

ENGINEERING – Dennis Carr, Ross Fuller & Mike Genard

- The Grandyle project is progressing well. All new storm sewer installations have been completed. Curb removals that were necessary for storm sewer installations have been poured back. Grandyle has been paved from Kingsbury to Elgin and is now open to thru traffic. With school back in session, we have asked

that the contractor keep all lanes passable for the morning commute. Stark has started to grade the existing landscape in preparation for new sidewalk to be installed. The concrete crew is scheduled to be on-site next week to begin forming up and pouring the sidewalk.

- Stark has completed all storm sewer installations on Grant St. for the SRTS project. Grading and dirt work is scheduled to begin next week. We anticipate that the new sidewalk will be poured upon completion of the Grandyle project. We set up a temporary mailbox bank for all Grant St. residents for the duration of the project. Upon completion of the sidewalk installation, all mailboxes will be reinstalled between the sidewalk and EOP.
- Four new storm sewer manholes have been installed for Phase II of Catherine reconstruction. We have come to a stopping point until we receive a verbal approval from the IEPA to begin new water service connections to the new main. Fingers crossed that this happens next week.
- American Asphalt has mobilized to town to begin Hot-In-Place-Recycling for this year's MFT project. All residents who are affected by this work have been notified with door hangers. No parking signs will be placed throughout the ROW the night before work will be done on the roads.
- After the rejection of the Candlewood Bridge Bid, staff has begun working with CMT to update the plans to concrete to get the project back out for a rebid. The letting date has not been established for the rebid yet.
- Some redesign for the Cedar Street Drainage Project is continuing. Now that we have potholed the utilities, the resident engineer is working to try to reduce the depths of certain storm sewer runs to achieve some cost savings.
- Staff has set up a meeting with Goat Springs, LLC to continue discussion on the potential for a compromise route for the Phase 2B Trunkline Project. Strand finalized some plan sheets so we wanted to sit down with them to discuss before it comes to the Council at a future Committee of the Whole.

FINANCE – Joanie Baxter

- FY24-25 Audit of which field work began August 4, 2025:
 - Continued Fixed Assets, Leases and Subscriptions
 - Journal Entries as required
 - Continued uploading requested documents
- Preparation of Department of Justice – Evidence Building Reimbursement Request #3 and final. This grant has now been fully expended and the quarterly report was changed to final at the DOJ's instruction. The only remaining task is for closeout which the DOJ will initiate now that all grant funds have been expended and a final report has been issued.
- Participation in Strategic Planning meeting for management staff
- Participation in three interviews of City-wide space needs study consultants
- Dennis and I met with representatives of Good Energy and later discussed with Mayor Stevens the situation with the upcoming contract renewal. As indicated in the email sent to Council, Good Energy, working on behalf of Peoria area communities (Peoria, Peoria County, Bartonville, West Peoria, Creve Coeur, Peoria Heights, Chillicothe, Washington, and Morton) was able to secure a new 24-month contract for electric aggregation which will continue to provide our citizens with a choice of electric supplier. The initial rate of **\$.094/kWh** will be in place for the first six months of the contract until the April 2026 meter read date. This compares very favorably to the current rate of **\$.129/kWh**. From May 2026 through June 2027, the rate will adjust to **\$.134/kWh**. The rate for the following six months is dependent on the 2026 MISO auction and is unknown at this time. Representatives stated that the rates for next summer could be as high as \$.15/kWh to \$.16/kWh and thus the program provides a hedge against the potential increases that may arise due to the lack of power generation in our region. There will just be one opt-out period in September for the new contract, but keep in mind the program allows for opt-out anytime during the contract without penalty. Currently, approximately 80% of Washington residents who are eligible, participate in the program.
- Jill processed and I reviewed payroll for August 15, 2025

- Utility Billing (August 2 - 15, 2025)
 - A total of 5,530 bills were processed for August, including 905 emailed bills (16.3%)
 - A total of 487 penalties were assessed for delinquent July bills
 - A total of 46 disconnects were processed for August, including 17 owing a balance, 23 with credit balances, and six with a zero balance
 - A total of 12 cutoffs were processed for June billing and 25 door knockers were distributed and 9 payment arrangements made
 - A total of one delinquent account was sent to Collections for July disconnects
 - New accounts and account closings processed:
 - 23 ins
 - 22 outs
 - Leak detection through RNI and Sensus Analytics software – 52 leaks were caught and residents/businesses notified

PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT – *Jon Oliphant & Joe Boyer*

- The August PZC meeting had one case: 1) A special use request of Katie and Kevin Beale to allow a residential non-owner-occupied short-term rental at 301 S. Main St. Staff previously completed the required inspection and recommends approval, as the property meets all of the applicable STR regulations. The PZC unanimously recommended approval. A first reading ordinance is scheduled for Monday's Council meeting and a second reading ordinance will be scheduled for the September 2 meeting.
- The last two remaining Washington Commercial Building and Property Improvement Grant Program agreements for Cherry Tree Shopping Center and the incoming Ben Franklin store are on Monday's Council agenda as second reading ordinances.
- Initial work has begun on an Enterprise Zone boundary expansion application to add some land near the intersection of Centennial Drive and McClugage Road into the Northern Tazewell County EZ. Property grading may begin soon to make the site closer to shovel-ready prior to the extension of utilities into the property and the building construction. It is anticipated that the Villages of Creve Coeur and Metamora will also begin preparing an application to add land from their respective municipalities into the EZ. East Peoria staff has indicated that they will also likely be seeking to add territory to its portion of the EZ, though that will likely be included with the Creve Coeur/Metamora application at a slightly later date. The required public hearing for the proposed expansion of the Washington portion of the EZ will tentatively be scheduled for either the September 2 or 9 Council meetings, pending further feedback from IL DCEO on which of two possible applications to pursue.
- Cana Lutheran Church has been granted permission to block the City-owned parking lot at 105 S. Elm on September 7 from 3-7 pm for an event aimed for youths. They will maintain access to the adjacent alleys for any vehicles that need to utilize them.
- Monday's Council agenda will include the renewal of an agreement with Brian Heller as the City's Hearing Officer. Having the code enforcement adjudication process has been extremely favorable in addressing cases that previously were more challenging to abate in an efficient manner. This would be a two-year agreement with a slight hourly pay increase to \$160 in the first year and \$165 in the second year. The City spent approximately \$1,700 in the first year using Mr. Heller's services.
- Monday's Council agenda will also include a first reading ordinance to reduce the time allowed for paying for a nuisance abatement charge from 45 days to seven days. This is the recommendation of the City Attorney and would allow for liens to be recorded sooner and hopefully significantly reduce the possibility of a property sale prior to the receipt of an abatement payment as occasionally occurs. In such cases, the City cannot collect from the new owner for outstanding abatement charges.
- Department heads and Mayor Stevens participated in interviews with the top three teams that responded to the recent RFQ for a citywide space study.

- Staff and Mayor Stevens had its quarterly meeting with PACVB staff. The focus of the meeting was to provide feedback on an initial community video that will be completed, as indicated in the City's current agreement. Further discussion on such a video will take place after staff internally evaluates its branding. The 2025 2Q report is attached.

PUBLIC SAFETY – Chief Stevens

- The speed trailer was on the 100 block of Lynn (northbound) from July 23 – July 26, 2025. The 85th percentile speed in this 25 MPH zone was 28 MPH, meaning 85% of vehicles detected were at 28 MPH or less. The 50th percentile was 23 MPH. Of 6,196 vehicles detected, 9 were clocked over 35 MPH. The mean speed was 21 MPH.
 - The speed trailer was on the 400 block of Hilldale from July 27 – August 4, 2025. The 85th percentile speed in this 25 MPH zone was 26 MPH. The 50th percentile was 22 MPH. Of 3,025 vehicles detected, 23 were clocked over 35 MPH. The mean speed was 20 MPH.
 - The speed trailer was on the on Kern westbound at Primrose from August 4 – August 9, 2025. The 85th percentile speed in this 25 MPH zone was 32 MPH. The 50th percentile was 26 MPH. Of 5,005 vehicles detected, 212 (4.2%) were clocked over 35 MPH. The mean speed was 25 MPH. The crash history for this part of Kern is 4 property damage crashes from 2020-August 12, 2025 (at S Wilmore, at Hillcrest, at Muller, and in the 1500 block, which is near Firethorn Drive).
 - WPD presented Officer Taylor a commendation for his coordination of National Night Out, one of WPD's largest community outreach efforts. We thank all of our officers and staff, the majority of whom have worked the event, and all of our community partners for the continued success of Washington's NNO.
 - An August 1 Owner, Architect and Contractor (OAC) Meeting with P.J. Hoerr confirmed that construction is on schedule for the new evidence storage facility.
 - Chief Stevens spoke at the Guns Save Life meeting in Peoria. Guns Save Life is a gun rights advocacy group that meets monthly in six Illinois cities.
 - Monthly outdoor warning siren tests showed a rotation problem with the Guth Rd siren, which did not continuously rotate (but made 1 complete turn). Ragan Communication provided service and will monitor the next test in person. Ragan Communication monitored the August test based on previous issues with this siren.
 - Patrol officers and sergeants scheduled traffic details at every school pick up and drop off time for the start of school. When officers were called away from the Thursday drop off detail, Chief Stevens still managed to stop a cell phone using driver near Central.
 - Officers Taylor and Westbrook conducted specialized active intruder training at Washington Community High School and Officer Taylor also conducted robbery response training at Heartland Bank.

PUBLIC WORKS – Brian Rittenhouse

- Water Treatment Plant #1 zone has switched to a free chlorine disinfection as of Wednesday, August 13th. Staff will continue to monitor closely with extra sampling.
 - Staff has started its annual detention basin inspections program. Staff will visually inspect and document any maintenance needed and complete any needed maintenance after inspections are completed.
 - Staff has started its annual mainline valve exercising program. The IEPA recommends that valves be exercised yearly to ensure they operate correctly.
 - Staff has been working with the Police Department and the Bicentennial Committee for the Bicentennial Parade. The parade route has been checked, and staff will stage needed traffic control Friday for Saturday's parade. Staff will also work and participate in the parade.

COMMUNICATIONS SPECIALIST – *Amanda Roberts*

- Promotion and coverage of Bicentennial events. Most recently featured Rove & Ramble on the Square and shared details for the upcoming Bicentennial Block Party and Skycentennial Drone Show.
 - Building agenda and activity plans for the upcoming City Rebrand Workshop. Materials and resources are being prepared to support an interactive, productive session.

- Following months of coordination and preparation, the Laserfiche public document portal has officially launched on the City's website, located under the Clerk's tab. This portal provides public access to a searchable collection of historic and official documents, allowing users to locate the materials and archival records they need. The initiative, led by the City Clerk's Office, is designed to enhance public access to information and promote transparency in our local government. Additional documents will be added on an ongoing basis.
- I had the privilege of hosting the bi-monthly Central Illinois Municipal Clerks Organization meeting at Tangled Roots, where 13 municipal clerks from across Central Illinois gathered to exchange information and share resources.

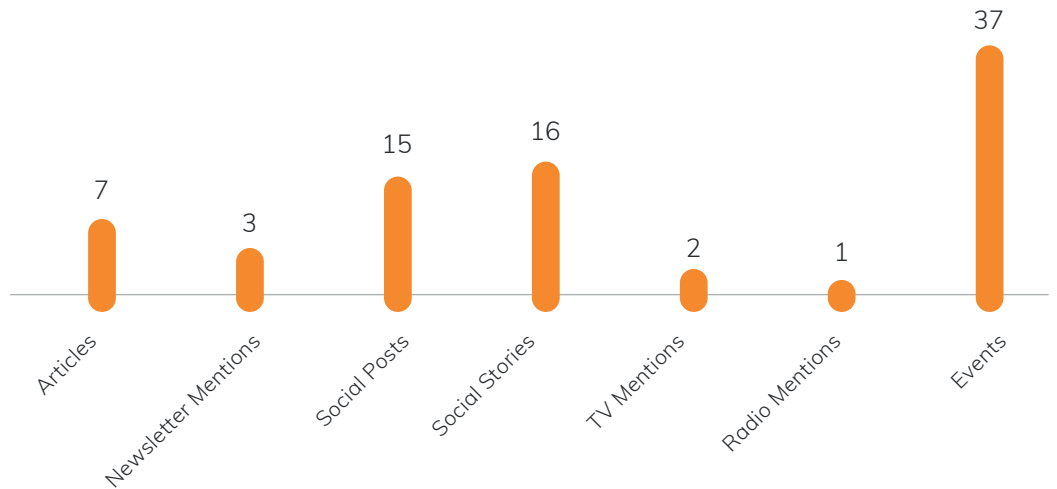
