AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE JURISDICTIONAL TRANSFER OF A PORTION OF NORTH MAIN STREET FROM TAZEWELL COUNTY TO THE CITY OF WASHIGTON

WHEREAS, the City of Washington (the "City") is a home rule unit of local government and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970;

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1, et seq., authorizes cooperative agreements between and among Illinois units of local government; and

WHEREAS, the City and Tazewell County, Illinois (the "County") have agreed to transfer from the County's jurisdiction that portion of North Main Street located from a point 880 ft (.167) north of North St. and thence north 0.51 miles to the north edge of the radius return of Cruger Rd. in its entirety to the municipal street system of the City of Washington, Tazewell County, Illinois, pursuant to the terms of the Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein as *Exhibit A* (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Washington desires and finds it to be in the best interests of the City and its residents to approve the jurisdictional transfer as set forth in the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, TAZEWELL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated as findings of fact as if said recitals were fully set forth herein.
- Section 2. The City Council approves and accepts the jurisdictional transfer of that portion of North Main Street located from a point 880 ft (.167) north of North St. and thence north 0.51 miles to the north edge of the radius return of Cruger Rd. in its entirety from Tazewell County into the municipal street system of the City of Washington, as set forth in the Agreement.
- <u>Section 3</u>. The City Council hereby approves, authorizes, and directs the Mayor or her designee to execute the Agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein as *Exhibit A* together with such other documents as may be necessary in furtherance of this Ordinance.
- <u>Section 4</u>. The City Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the State of Illinois through its Regional Engineer's office at Peoria, Illinois.
- Section 5. This Ordinance is in addition to all other ordinances on the subject and shall be construed therewith except as to that part in direct conflict with any other ordinance, and in the event of such conflict, the provisions hereof shall govern.

<u>Section 6</u>. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
