Agenda Item: Purchase Authorization – Square Lighting LED Upgrades

**Explanation**: Staff has experienced ongoing maintenance issues with the lights on the square from

lamps going out, colors not matching or ballast going bad, making lights flicker or just not turning on. Staff asked RnS Electric to investigate the cost of replacing City owned lights around the Square and in the two parking lots located Northeast and Southeast of

the Square.

The project would consist of bypassing the ballast, removing/disposing of the existing High-Intensity Discharge (HID) Lamps and installing new LED Lamps.

LED Lights are more energy efficient and last longer than HID Lamps. Typically, when a lamp is out it is either the lamp itself or a bad ballast. LED lights do not require ballast, therefore eliminating ballast as a future maintenance item.

The below table shows the location, how many poles and description.

The lamps have a 5-year warranty with a 1-year installation warranty.

**Fiscal Impact**: \$23,569.00. There are sufficient funds to cover the lighting project.

**Recommendation**: Staff would recommend Purchase Authorization to contract RnS to complete the

Square Lighting Upgrades.

**Action Requested**: Approve Purchase Authorization of up to \$23,569.00 to Contract RnS Electric to perform the LED Upgrades on the Square and Adjacent City owned parking lots.


