Award of bid is anticipated to be on Monday, February 21st, 2022.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Term of Contract

This Contract shall take effect May 1, 2022, and expire on April 30, 2023.

2. Liquid Chlorine

It is the intent of the City of Washington to purchase and receive delivery of approximately sixty (60), 150-pound cylinders of Liquid Chlorine for use at its Water Treatment Plant No. 1 and Sewage Treatment Plant No. 2 during the term of this Contract. The City also expects to purchase and receive delivery of eight (8), 2,000-pound containers of Liquid Chlorine for use at its Water Treatment Plant No. 2.

3. Hydrofluosilicic Acid

The City intends to purchase and receive delivery of approximately sixty-five (65), 300-pound drums of 23% Hydrofluosilicic Acid for use at its Water Treatment Plants No. 1 and No. 2. The acid content shall be in conformance with AWWA standards currently in effect, and the content shall be clearly marked on the cylinders, the shipping notice, and the invoice.

4. <u>Liquid Ferric Chloride</u>

The City intends to purchase and receive delivery of approximately 16,000 gallons (180,000 pounds) of 38% to 42% liquid ferric chloride for use at its Sewage Treatment Plant No. 2. Orders for liquid ferric chloride will be made in quantity of no less than 2,000 gallons. The liquid ferric chloride shall be in conformance with AWWA standards currently in effect, and the content shall be clearly marked on the shipping notice and the invoice.

5. Polymers

The City intends to purchase and receive delivery of approximately 9,500 pounds of polymers for use at its Sewage Treatment Plant No. 2. Orders for polymers will be made in quantities of no less than 2000 pounds. The polymers used shall be in conformance with AWWA standards currently in effect, and the content shall be clearly marked on the shipping notice and the invoice.

6. Phosphate

The City <u>intends</u> to purchase and receive delivery of approximately 10,000 pounds of WSU 350 PO4 phosphate in 50-pound bags. There will be no exceptions to the WSU 350 product.

7. Quantities

The quantities shown herein are estimated for canvassing purposes only, and as such may not represent the actual quantities required during the term of any contract made pursuant to these specifications. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as an obligation of the City of Washington to order or pay for any quantity of material other than that amount determined to meet the actual requirements of the City. The right is reserved to increase or decrease the quantities shown herein at any time during the life of the contract. The City will be obligated to pay for only the actual quantities ordered and received.

8. Basis of Award

Bids will be canvassed on the basis of the unit price and extended total as shown on Page P-1 of the Proposal. Awards may be made to different suppliers for individual commodities. The City reserves the right to waive technicalities or to reject any and all bids when, in the opinion of the City Council, the best interests of the City of Washington will be served by such action.

9. Ordering and Delivery

Orders shall be placed by telephone direct to the Vendor by personnel of the City of Washington, Department of Public Works. A list of authorized personnel will be furnished to the Vendor upon request.

The Vendor will furnish and deliver to the job site the ordered quantities no later than one week after placement of the order. The delivery method will be by appropriate trucking.

10. Billing

All invoices for accepted quantities should be sent to the City of Washington, 301 Walnut Street, Washington, Illinois 61571. All invoices must clearly show the description, quantity received, unit price, and City of Washington's **Purchase Order number**.

11. Price Escalation

The prices quoted herein shall remain firm for the contract period.

12. Certification of Compliance

In accordance with Article 33E of the Criminal Code of 1961, as amended, the bidder is required to fill out and submit with his proposal the Certification of Compliance included with this bid document.

13. Exceptions to Specifications

Any exceptions to these specifications shall be clearly explained on a separate page by the bidder on his firm's letterhead, to be attached to and submitted with these documents prior to

or at the time of bid opening. Should a bidder submit a proposal without a separate statement of exception, it shall be assumed the proposal is in full compliance with these specifications.

14. Corrections

All prices and notations must be typed in or written in ink.
