This letter is being delivered to inform residents of a locally funded project that is scheduled begin Monday, July 21. The City has contracted Stark Excavating for a much-needed storm water priority project that will also include the installation of sidewalk. The project will begin with installation of new storm sewer main, manholes, and inlets throughout the roadway to increase drainage throughout the surrounding area. Upon the completion of new storm sewer system, sidewalk will be poured along the northwest side of Grandyle from Mackenzie to Elgin. To conclude the project, new asphalt will be placed on Grandyle throughout the project limits. The project is expected to be finished by early September.

Beginning late this week you may begin to see signage and traffic control staged for the project. Some saw cutting in the road and driveways may be done as well. For the duration of the project Grandyle. will be closed to through traffic. The contractor has been asked to adjust their working hours once school begins to limit the impacts for bus routes and school traffic. Residents living on Grandyle will have access to their driveways by the end of each working day barring any unforeseen circumstances. When the new sidewalk is poured, there will be a few days when driveways will not be accessible while the new concrete cures. You will be notified before this happens. There will be no interruption in garbage pickup or mail delivery. We apologize for any inconvenience that this project may cause.
