Call to Order: The City of Washington Board of Police Commissioners met in the Police Department Training Room pursuant to the posting of an agenda as required.

Motion: Secretary Balistreri motioned to approve Eric Erbentraut for a conditional offer of employment for the position of Patrol Officer, pending successful completion of the polygraph and psychological evaluations. Commissioner Vaughn seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Discussion: Administrative Officer Beth Duley will provide the Commission with the candidates' polygraph and psychological evaluation information in a password-protected file for individual review once both evaluations have been completed. Commissioners will review the materials individually in preparation for discussion and any necessary action at a future meeting.

If any matters arise from the evaluations that warrant further discussion, the Commission may request that the candidates appear before the Board for follow-up in executive session.
