

9/14/15 Public Safety Committee meeting 5:30PM (City Hall)

Members present: T. Gee, D. Dingleline, T. Maxwell, Chief D. Volk

Chairman Gee called meeting to order @ 5:30PM.

Alderman wishing to be heard – M. Brownfield brought forward a request from Brandon Burget (607 Agnes) to consider making Agnes/Kingsbury a 3-way stop intersection. D. Dingleline provided some history with regards to stop signs and not using them for speed control. T. Gee discussed the possibility of painting crosswalks to slow traffic or lowering the speed limit in the area of LaHood Park. T. Maxwell discussed parking on only one side of the roadway, to provide better visibility or marking crosswalks better. Chief Volk offered to place the speed trailer in the area to provide traffic volume info. Chief Volk also advised that if crosswalks are to be considered that they must be ADA compliant. T. Gee then suggested the possibility of “Yield to Pedestrian” signs. The Committee agreed to further consider the request after the traffic volume info was gathered.

Citizens wishing to be heard – None.

Approval of minutes for August 10th, 2015 regular meeting – T. Maxwell motioned, D. Dingleline seconded. Approved.

Business items – Monthly reports were reviewed and discussed.

Other Business – Chief Volk advised he received a telephone call from Ellen Brown (601 Ridge, #241-0708) in regards to wanting an ordinance to muzzle all Pit Bulls and Pit Bull mixes. Committee did not wish to pursue this request. Chief Volk also received a call from John Schultz (609 S. Main, #444-4472) in regards to reducing S. Main St. speed limit from 1100 block to City edge. Committee did not wish to pursue this request. Chief Volk advised that Alderman Moss had asked for flags to be placed on new S. Main speed limit coming northbound into town. City Services already did this. Chief Volk provided additional info to keep Committee up to speed on the 9-1-1 legislation change.
