Public Hearing – Proposed FY17-18 Budget	A public hearing was opened for comment at 6:30 p.m. in the Library Meeting Room at Five Points Washington by Mayor Manier for the purpose of hearing comments to the City’s proposed FY17-18 Budget. City Administrator Culotta provided both an expense and revenue overview of the proposed \$27M budget. He thanked elected officials, department heads and staff for their work in the process of budget preparation and recognized Controller Baxter for all her hard work in compiling the final budget document.
Comments	Alderman Dingledine shared that it is nice to see a decrease in the anticipated budget while maintaining our services and it shows we are doing our best to rein in expenditures.
