

What do I need to get a Residential Parking Permit?

If you live on a permit parking block:

- Provide proof of the address of your home: (IL license or ID, utility bill, verifiable lease, for examples)
- Provide Illinois registration for the vehicles for which you want a permit: (must be registered to the resident)

For your guests or invitees (up to 30 days):

- Provide proof of the address of your home: (IL license or ID, utility bill, verifiable lease, for examples)
- Provide a description (make and color) and the license plate number and state of any vehicle to get a temporary permit valid up to 30 days.

For persons who regularly do business with you at your home (like your cleaning person):

- Provide proof of the address of your home: (IL license or ID, utility bill, verifiable lease, for examples)
- Provide a description and the license plate number and state of any vehicle and the reason you need such a permit for this vehicle to get a temporary or annual permit good only on the block and same side of the street as your property. The temporary permit is a hangtag that must be displayed on the rearview mirror and the annual permit is a sticker.

For your short-term guests at your home:

- Provide proof of the address of your home: (IL license or ID, utility bill, verifiable lease, for examples)
- Provide a description and the license plate number and state of any vehicle and the reason you need such a permit for this vehicle to get a 4-hour permit. This permit is a hangtag that must be displayed on the rearview mirror.

If you own property on a permit parking block but don't live there:

For your own permit(s):

- Provide proof of the address of property you own (your identification, which we will match to tax records – if you own or manage a company that owns the property, provide proof of this)
- Provide Illinois registration for the vehicles for which you want a permit: (must be registered to the property owner)

Owners get regular permits for any vehicle they own and have registered in IL

For your guests or invitees:

- Provide proof of the address of property you own (your identification, which we will match to tax records – if you own or manage a company that owns the property, provide proof of this)
- Provide a description (make and color) and the license plate number and state of any vehicle to get a temporary permit valid up to 30 days and good only on the block and same side of the street as your property.

For persons who regularly do business with you at the property (like your property maintenance person):

- Provide proof of the address of property you own (your identification, which we will match to tax records – if you own or manage a company that owns the property, provide proof of this)
- Provide a description and the license plate number and state of any vehicle and the reason you need such a permit for this vehicle to get a temporary or annual permit good only on the block and same side of the street as your property.
