City Hall will open temporarily to receive petition filings for City of Washington elected positions, Monday, November 16, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. and remain open until 9:30 a.m. or the completion of receiving the early filings. After such time, anyone wishing to submit petitions may contact City Clerk, Valeri Brod at 309-444-1137 to make arrangements for filing during regular office hours, November 16 – 23, 2020.

It is recommended that candidates complete the entire packet prior to their arrival, however notary services will be made available at the time of filing.

Petition packets and Candidate Guides are available to download on the City of Washington website as well as the Tazewell County Clerk's office or website.

 - Mayor – 4-Year Term
 - City Clerk – 4-Year Term
 - City Treasurer – 4-Year Term
 - Alderman, Ward I – 4-Year Term
 - Alderman, Ward II – 4-Year Term
 - Alderman, Ward III – 4-Year Term
 - Alderman, Ward IV – 4-Year Term
 - Alderman, Ward IV – 2-Year Unexpired Term

- If needed, a Primary Election is to be held Tuesday, February 23, 2021.
- If a Primary Election is not needed, the Consolidated Election is to be held Tuesday, April 6, 2021.
- City Hall is staffed Monday – Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- City Hall is located at 301 Walnut Street, Washington, 309-444-3496
- Masks are encouraged when entering City Hall at this time.
