Announcing...The **NEW** Disability Transit Service for  
Washington Urban Area Residents beginning  
August 1, 2022 !!!



The City of Washington, Washington Township, CityLift and the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission have arranged funding to support a six month trial Disability Transit Service for qualified (Ages 18-59) City (Urban) residents of Washington. This service will provide local disability transit service within the City for \$3 each way, as well as to service points in East Peoria and Peoria for \$6 each way. Similar service for persons age 60 and older is available through Central Illinois Agency on Aging, Ph. 309-674-2071.

Disabled residents wishing to ride CityLift must first submit a rider application to Washington Township for approval. The application is very easy to fill out, and does require a medical professional sign off. Printed applications are available at all Washington medical and physical therapy locations, local churches, as well as the Library, City Hall and Washington Township offices. Downloadable applications are also available on line at the City of Washington website and the Washington Township website ([www.toi.org/township/tazewell-county-washington/](http://www.toi.org/township/tazewell-county-washington/)). All applications must be turned in to the Township office located at 58 Valley Forge Drive, directly behind Hardee's in Washington.
